"Removal of Snow and Ice on Sidewalks"

Winter is upon us and with that comes snow and the potential for ice on our sidewalks.

Riggins Municipal Code states, "It is the duty of the owner or tenant of any premises abutting or adjoining a public sidewalk to remove all snow and/or ice from such sidewalk".

Your cooperation is appreciated.

When a significant snowfall occurs (2" or more), the City Public Works crew will plow snow from sidewalks as a public service for those residents who are unable to clear their own sidewalks.

NO TRUCK IDLING IN CITY LIMITS

In accordance with Municipal Code 10.2.27: "Motor Vehicles Not to be Parked with Engines Running: No driver of a motor vehicle shall leave the same unattended upon any street or public place while any part of the machinery is running or in motion".
