### **ALTERNATE DAY SPRINKLING/WATERING IN EFFECT**

Due to the high demand for water, in order to insure that all users have adequate water for irrigation, alternate day sprinkling and watering is in effect for both domestic well water and the Irrigation Ditch.

**NORTH** of the Elementary School = **EVEN** days  
**SOUTH** of Elementary School(including the School) = **ODD** days

Hand Watering - allowed at all times.

All set sprinklers are subject to the Alternate Day Schedule.  
The Riggins City Council asks for your cooperation to help make water available for the duration of the summer.

**NORTH=EVEN**

**SOUTH=ODD**

## **Rattle the Canyon 2021 Benefits Stage**

Our purpose for this event was to generate \$\$ for the City Park Stage and give back to the community who have so generously supported this project: donors, vendors, volunteers and cheerleaders.

To date the building of the stage expense is \$44,000 for labor and materials.

We are happy to say we have the materials on hand to finish the bathroom and sheetrock most of the back stage interior. Progress continues even though you may not see or know it.

## CITY PARK BOAT RAMP – GRANT \$\$ RECEIVED

We're very pleased to announce the City was awarded another grant from  
*Idaho Parks & Recreation Waterways Improvement Fund*  
to complete Phase 2 of the Riggins Park Boat Ramp Project!

Both Phase 1 (access road), and Phase 2 (boat ramp),  
will be completed this year with construction to begin in August  
*and completion the end of December 2021.*

Bids for the project will be out in July.
