
Gifts will be wrapped and Food Boxes will be distributed Thursday, December 16th from 1-3 pm at the Riggins Community Center.

CITY PARK BOAT RAMP PROJECT UPDATE:



Advertisement for Bids for the project have been published, and is available on the City's website: www.rigginsidaho.org. All sealed bids must be received at City Hall by 10 a.m. on December 8th and then will be publicly opened and read aloud. All interested individuals are welcome to attend.

The project will involve demolition of the existing concrete boat ramp, gabion wall repair, grading, excavation, installation of new gabion retaining wall, replacement of concrete boat ramp, riprap, asphalt as shown on plans, curbs, hydroseeding, catch basins and storm pipe.

In addition, there are some Add Alternates included in the bids:

#1 - installation of a 42" chain link fence;

#2 – adding the concrete staging area including anchor rings, riprap, etc.;

#3 – installation of prefabricated steel stairs including all supports, bracing, foundations, railing, landings and other parts;

#4 – addition of precast concrete planks for all underwater work associated with the boat ramp.

A contractor will be chosen for the project at the December City Council meeting.

We are beyond excited to get this project off the ground!

Susan has a lot on her list of job


