### PUBLIC WORKS CORNER

**EFFICIENT LAWN WATERING:** These water efficient lawn watering practices can help maintain a beautiful yard and **conserve valuable city water supplies:**

Water only grass areas (not sidewalks or driveways); use hand held soakers for small trees and plants; use shut-off nozzles on hoses and repair leaky hoses and fittings.

Also, to reduce the amount of water lost to evaporation, water during the cool part of the day, and mow to a height of 3" which shades the roots and soil surface.

Property owners with access to the City Irrigation Ditch will receive an additional insert with their June billing detailing information on the new maintenance fee for the Laterals.

customers who apply for assistance. They can help restore  
services if a resident has been disconnected, or prevent getting  
disconnected if folks are having trouble paying their water bill.
