CITY PARK BOAT RAMP PROJECT UPDATE:


As you've probably noticed, the project is moving right along. This phase, which involves replacing the concrete boat ramp, will be completed by the end of March. The City will find out in May if we are successful with another grant application through *Idaho Parks & Recreation Waterways Improvement Fund*. If so, these funds will be used to complete the access road phase this fall that includes the base rock, asphalt, curbing, improving storm water drainage to reduce erosion in the river, and installation of a metal stair structure to improve pedestrian access and safety.


