## ORDINANCE NO. 159

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RIGGINS, IDAHO COUNTY, IDAHO, AMENDING ORDINANCE #158 WHICH ESTABLISHED THE SPEED LIMIT TO 25 MPH IN THE INCORPARATED LIMITS OF THE CITY OF RIGGINS, IDAHO, ALONG US HIGHWAY #95.

WHEREAS, the City of Riggins, is an incorporated city of the State of Idaho and has the authority, pursuant to Title 49, Section 207, Idaho Code, and recognized by the Idaho Transportation Department, to regulate the speeds of vehicles traveling along roads within Riggins's city limits; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor, and City Council of Riggins deem it necessary to the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Riggins to limit the speed of vehicles traveling on US Highway #95, within the corporate limits of Riggins;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIGGINS, IDAHO COUNTY, IDAHO that Ordinance #158 be amended to read as follows:

Section 1: The speed limit along US Highway #95 from the Northern boundary of Riggins city limits, near Cemetery Road to MP 194.58 (approximately twenty-five yards south of Flume Gulch) within the incorporated city limits of the City of Riggins, shall be no greater than 25 mph and that such speed limit be so posted.

Section 2: The speed limit along US highway #95 from MP 194.58 (approximately twenty-five yards south of Flume Gulch) to the Southern boundary of the Riggins city limits shall be 35 mph and that such speed limit be so posted.

<u>Section 3:</u> Any person exceeding the posted speed limit shall be guilty of an infraction as defined in Title 49 Section 654, Idaho Code and shall be subject to the punishments set forth therein as such section may be amended from time to time.

<u>Section 4:</u> This Ordinance shall be published once in the Idaho County Free Press, and shall become effective upon its passage, approval, and publication.
