CITY OF RIGGINS RESOLUTION # 24-2

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Riggins has passed Ordinance #53, which prohibits the consumption or possession of alcohol on the city streets and sidewalks, and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Riggins has reserved the right by affirmative vote of the majority of the Council to temporarily suspend the enforcement of this ordinance during specific times for organized city-wide celebrations or similar events, by passage of Ordinance #120, and

WHEREAS, the community is sponsoring the Women with Bait Fish Dance on March 16, the Salmon River Jet Boat Races on April 19-21, the Riggins Rodeo on May 4-5, the Big Water Blowout on June 1, Rattle the Canyon Music Festival on June 22, and Hot Summer Nights on July 19-20, and they have, together with the business community of the City of Riggins, requested that the City Council waive the enforcement of Ordinance #53 during the weekend of these events, now

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council, in consideration of the above information of the organized, city-wide events and the request made from the community and business owners, meeting the criteria established in Ordinance #120, have agreed, by affirmative vote to grant a waiver of Ordinance #53, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the specified hours of the waiver of Ordinance #53 shall be limited to the following:

Women with Bait Fish Dance: 3 pm, Friday March 15, 2024 until 10 am, Sunday March 17, 2024 Salmon River Jet Boat Races: 12 pm, Friday April 19, 2024 until 10 pm, Sunday April 21, 2024 Riggins Rodeo: 12 pm, Friday May 3, 2024 until 10 pm, Sunday May 5, 2024 Big Water Blowout: 12 pm, Friday May 31, 2024 until 10 am, Sunday June 2, 2024 Rattle the Canyon: 12 pm, Friday June 21, 2024 until 10 am, Sunday, June 23, 2024 Hot Summer Nights: 12 pm, Friday July 19, 2024 until 10 am, Sunday July 21, 2024

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the waiver of Ordinance #53 shall be limited to the designated areas adjacent to Summerville's and Seven Devils Saloon and the sidewalk on the east side of US#95 between those properties, which areas shall be clearly defined, marked, and fenced by barriers and approved by the City of Riggins. Such barriers shall be located on the sidewalk curb, or adjacent gutter, placed so as not to impede highway or sidewalk traffic. Public sidewalks located within the designated area shall not be blocked by the barriers, and must be kept clear of all chairs, tables and all other structures, so as not to impede the flow of pedestrian traffic, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Ordinance #53 will be strictly enforced at all times, on all public streets and sidewalks in the City, with the exception of the above stated hours within the designated areas specifically described above.
